## **NOTES**

This liturgy embodies the offering up of all creation for consecration by Divine power. it is partly original and partly compiled from various sources.

'A Liturgy on Creation' is not a sacramental act In the same theological sense as the celebration of the Holy Eucharist. Bread and wine are not used. Questions of Holy Orders do not arise. so the celebrant might be a priest, but might also be a lay man or woman.

This Liturgy stands, then, in its own right as a spiritual work which may be done at any time, by any individual or group. You will note that the prayers are arranged in the same overall pattern as those of the Eucharist Itself. This new Liturgy, if used during the week, will amplify the familiar words of the Sunday Mass to a new dimension. It can therefore become a valuable means of strengthening co-operation between priest and people when Sunday Mass is offered. It could also be used at times when no ordained priest is available.

The simple ritual directions given In the text are for group celebrations, but of course 'A liturgy on Creation' might also be used by an individual as a purely private prayer or devotion, with or without an altar.

For a group celebration, a table is covered with a white cloth. If desired, a cross and either two or six candies may be used. No bread, wine, chalice, paten or other instruments or vestments should be used, although the leader might wear a simple white robe.

(In the Offering (p. 4) the chalice and the paten are referred to symbolically. and are not intended to be used as such. In the Holy Eucharist, the paten is the golden dish on which the bread is offered. and the chalice is the cup in which the wine is offered

Unless otherwise stated. the leader's hands are joined (palms together) throughout.

Passages in square brackets may be omitted.

that in our lives your life shall be revealed


